THE ROAD TO DJ LAB PRO

DJ LAB PRO didn't appear out of nowhere. Its structure, values, and vision are the result of years of hands-on experience at the intersection of independent culture, music education, the electronic scene, and European support networks for emerging artists.

In 2022, Maiko DJ LAB (now VG DJ LAB) was founded — an educational initiative for DJs focused on mindset, performance, and long-term creative growth. The program quickly gained recognition and was selected for the **HEMI Incubator 2023**, a European platform supporting music innovation across Central, Eastern, and Southeastern Europe.

In 2023, Virtual Geisha became the curator of the **Fresh Faces Stage at Carbon Silesia Festival**, offering rising talents their first real chance to perform on a major stage. She also co-developed the **Carbon Academy**, an educational program accompanying the festival, aimed at building artist resilience and career readiness.

Her international experience includes representing Poland at the **Amsterdam Dance Event 2024** (Meet the Professionals program), participating in the Polish export mission to **Iceland Airwaves**, being a part of the **Music Export Academy** (2023).

Each of these steps was a conscious move towards building a scalable, empathetic, and professional support ecosystem for emerging DJs and producers.

DJ LAB PRO is the natural culmination of this journey — a project that merges local identity with European standards, creativity with smart delegation, and artistic freedom with structural thinking.
